Why is this important? Look at the candidates.

The Race: A Democrat-leaning district with 53% of voters voting for Obama in 2012. Incumbent Fajardo won by only 400 votes in 2014. Brian Egolf stated in March that this is a seat Democrats could win.

Democratic Candidate: Arturo Fierro

- Endorsed by Working Families Party, SWOP Action, AFSCME, NEA NM, & AFT NM
- Opposes Right to Work, the death penalty, using test scores in teacher evaluations
- Supports creating an Ethics Commission, using permanent funds to expand funding to early childhood, increasing investment in job-creation and entrepreneurship, and increasing taxes on the top 1%
- Young Latino who is new to politics, a Veteran, and social worker.

Republican Candidate: Kelly Fajardo

- Right-to-Lifer
- Voted to reinstate the death penalty at the special session
- Very pro-business, serving on the Board of the Greater Belen Chamber of Commerce
- One of the lowest ranked members of the House by Conservation Voters of NM, with a 17% approval rating for 2015-16 and a 12% lifetime score. Clearly not very green.
- Endorsed by the NRA and big supporter of their efforts to prevent all limitations on gun access
