As Fred Harris (2015) put it in the preface to *New Mexico 2050*, “the most fundamental things we must do in New Mexico . . . is to improve and invest more generously in education outcomes” (xiii). *The preliminary research objective for the topic of reimagining education is to examine how best to facilitate a sea-change in thinking about education in New Mexico in the context of reinventing our relationships with the natural world and with each other.*
